FELICITY FRANKLIN HIGH SCHOOL ACCOMPLISHMENTS

Last May Arica Stutz broke the school record for the 110 meter hurdles at the semi-final state competition. Her mother Cara Morrison Stutz (1982) had held this record until it was broken first by her daughter Marissa (2009) and then by Arica.

For the first time in school history the Academic Team advances to regional competition. On April 30th the team will compete at Shawnee State with 100 other teams drawn from 617 districts in Ohio.

The Felicity-Franklin FFA currently ranks in the top 10 chapters in the state, out of 300 Chapters, and awaits its final ranking which will be revealed at the Ohio State FFA Convention on May 6th. This is also a school first.

The Felicity-Franklin girl's softball team finished as regional runners-up in state competition with a record of 21-2.

Felicity Village's 175th Anniversary Celebration

May 13-15th Felicity will be celebrating the 175th anniversary of the village.

Each day there will be parades. There will be live music, dances, a walking tour, historical re-enactments, a display of photos and artifacts, cornhole, quilt & flower show, kid's games, and food vendors, etc. An antique tractor show and car shows are being planned also. The churches plan on having an ice cream social on Saturday.

Kathy Honea, author of the Van Briggles book; has agreed to come and portray Charity Van Briggles. Charity is the grandmother of Artus Van Briggles, the world-renowned potter who lived his first 17 years here in Felicity. There will be a display of some of his works at the Community Building.

The walking tour consists of 23 stops some are the Underground Railroad houses. There will be historical figures portraying the people who lived there.

Originally called Feestown, the village was renamed by the founder's daughter, Margaret Fee, in 1836. Felicity means happiness.

William Fee bought the land in 1806. He and partner Peter Hastings laid out 72 lots and six streets on 22 1/2 acres in 1817. The first lot was bought in 1818 by John McGraw, who paid \$60. The village, which continued to be laid out until 1846, now encompasses 147 acres.

The village was incorporated on March 14, 1836, but the celebration will be held in May hoping that the weather will be better.

A book is being published that includes historic maps, photos, newspaper clippings and the reminiscences of residents. Because the book is getting so big some information may be held for another book to be published for the Franklin Township's Bicentennial that will be in 2018.
